

What you need to play: One dice and dolphin game pieces (see next page)

How to play: Everyone puts their dolphin game pieces on the start section. To start, each player rolls the dice and the one with the highest roll of the dice starts first. Each player rolls the dice and moves forward that number of spaces. If a player lands in a space with instructions to move forward or back they must follow them. If a player lands on a space with an action (in CAPITAL LETTERS) they must perform that action or lose a turn. The player that lands on Tobermory Bay first, wins!

In the game you may be asked to ECHOLOCATE and whistle. Dolphins use ECHOLOCATION to locate food. To do this they send out clicking sounds and wait for the sound to bounce back to them to tell them where the food is. Dolphins use whistling noises to communicate with each other.

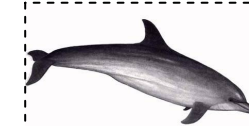

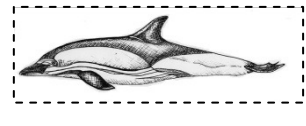
